As of 14 th of December 2019

strict regulations apply to plants and plant products imported in travel packages!



YOU ARE ADVISED NOT TO BRING ANY PLANTS OR PLANT PRODUCTS HOME IN YOUR PERSONAL LUGGAGE

As of 14 December 2019

all plants for planting (e.g. potted plants, seeds and propagating materials), fruits (e.g. apples, hazelnuts) and other plant products (e.g. wreaths and fresh herbs), including those carried in private individuals' luggage, can be imported from non-EU countries only if they have a phytosanitary certificate.*

The new regulations to be applied from 14 December 2019 require a mandatory check of personal luggage, and impose stricter rules on plants and plant products imported in small quantities (quantities for personal consumption). This means that some plants, even a single fruit, bud or crop of such plants, to be imported from a third country to the Member States of the European Union must have a phytosanitary certificate.

Plants and plant products imported without a phytosanitary certificate shall be destroyed by the competent authority.





Let's prevent pests of non-native plants causing great economic and natural damage from entering Hungary and the European Union.



^{*} Exceptions to the above requirement are pineapples, bananas, dates, durian and coconuts, processed plant products (e.g. dried fruits, preserved vegetables and fruits), as well as plants and plant products from Switzerland.
