Release Notes — Version 8.2.1

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New Features

Grouping (Due Diligence Statements & Simplified Declarations)

- Operators can now create and submit a **Group Head** (DDS and SD) via both the GUI and API.
- DDS group heads may group DDS and/or SD members; SD group heads may group SD members only.
- Group Heads receive a dedicated reference number and visual badge for easy identification in search results.
- Search and filter capabilities for Group Heads, including a dedicated checkbox to show/hide grouped items in the main search grid.
- View and edit group head details, with navigation from the group head detail to its group members (opens in a new tab).
- Withdraw and amend Group Heads within the 72-hour window from when the reference number becomes visible.
- Grouped members are locked from reuse, amendment, or independent customs presentation once the group head is submitted.
- SME Downstream Operators or Traders can verify the validity of upstream Group Heads.
- Non-SME Downstream Operators or Traders can access and verify the validity of upstream Group Heads.
- Supports up to 1000 DDS/SD members per group submission.

Simplified Declaration (SD) Versioning

- Full SD versioning support across all API operations: submit, update, get, withdraw, and lookup by identifiers or internal reference.
- SD version number is now displayed on generated PDFs.
- Versioning is reflected in the UI with appropriate visual cues and labels.

Operator Registration & Profiles

- **Non-EU Operator management** — extended operator profile management for non-EU operators, including address management and CA activity permissions.
- **Register as SME or Non-SME Downstream Operator or Trader** — New selectable roles in the registration workflow for operators fulfilling EUDR obligations.
- **Micro & Small Primary Operator** can now search, create, manage lifecycle, edit internal reference, copy, and generate PDF for Simplified Declarations.
- Removed non-applicable operator identifiers (IMO management, IMO owner, TRACES Number, NIRMS Number) from the identifier list.

Multi-Operator API Authentication

- API users belonging to more than one EUDR operator can now call the EUDR SOAP endpoints by specifying which operator they act as, using the **BodyIdentity** SOAP header with the operator's Web Service Identifier.
- Automatic generation of Web Service identifiers for new operator registrations.

Verification Enhancements

- **Verification Response** — verification returns VALID, NOT VALID, or NOT FOUND verification results for upstream references.
- **Full Declaration Content View** — Non-SME downstream operators can view the full content of a DDS or SD via a dedicated content-checking function (separate from verify-existence), after providing the reference number and verification number.
- Display DDS/SD verification/view results in the UI.

Bug Fixes

This release includes numerous stability and reliability fixes across the EUDR module.
